Dear Friends,

I recently held Collective Worship at St James CE School in Wetherby. Their theme for the term is 'perseverance' and the pupils gave some excellent examples. One was of climbing up a hill which was steep and very hard, another of rock climbing and getting a medal. They also gave two perspectives of getting strength, from both eating the right foods and helping each other. As it was a new term, most of the pupils had gone up a year, and there were some new faces too, who were getting used to being in a class, and having this strange person talking to them about Jesus!

The Bible story I chose was from Luke 5, in The Lion Children's Bible. People had heard about Jesus and "when he began to heal those who were ill, the news spread like wildfire. People came from far and near, and Jesus was busy from morning till night...but he never turned people away." He asked Simon Peter to take his boat out into the lake and Jesus taught them from there. Afterwards, he asked him to take the boat out further and cast out their nets. Simon Peter told Jesus that they were tired, they had been out all night and not caught anything, but he obeyed Jesus and with Andrew they put the nets out. They caught so many fish that their nets were breaking and they needed some help!

I talked about the story with the children and asked who was showing perseverance? Both Jesus, and Simon Peter and Andrew. Jesus didn't give up on the people, he didn't turn them away, he carried on teaching even though he must have been tired. Simon Peter and Andrew took the risk, even though they perhaps thought it was worthless, and were no doubt very surprised at happy at the quantity of fish they had caught!

So, here are some questions for you, because they are not just for the children....

- When did you or someone you know show perseverance?
- How does it feel when you achieve something that was hard to do?
- Where or from whom do you find strength to persevere?

At the District Synod, Revd Romeo Pedro, District Chair, shared with us his thoughts for the District and our churches. He had four words –

Remembering. Reimagine. Risk. Review.

I made lots of notes, but just to break it down small....

- Remembering with gratitude: remembering is not the same as returning. Christian memory should give us roots, not chains.
- Reimagine with hope: What might Methodism look like in 5 years? God is always waiting for us in the future. There is no journey without risk.
- Risk with faith: take a risk for the gospel, rather than preserve through fear (*that's a good quote!*)
- Review with humility: What have we learned? Where did we see God? Who did we not hear? Be willing to learn.

Rev Romeo also said “Decline is not the only story available to us.”

There is a sense of perseverance here too...keep looking for where God is, and join in. Keep taking risks and try new things. They may not work, or perhaps they will. Stop. Listen. Discern. Rev Romeo spoke of a Southern African saying, ‘Ubuntu’ (which you may remember Revd Joseph Kwallah talking about) which means “I am because we are”. We belong together. We are in this together. God is with us.

And a comment came from a member of Synod watching online....

‘Get on with it, this is Yorkshire!’

Have a perseverance attitude (I’m talking to myself here too): keep persevering and find strength from Jesus and from each other.

Please pray for all the conversations on the work of God in our churches this month:

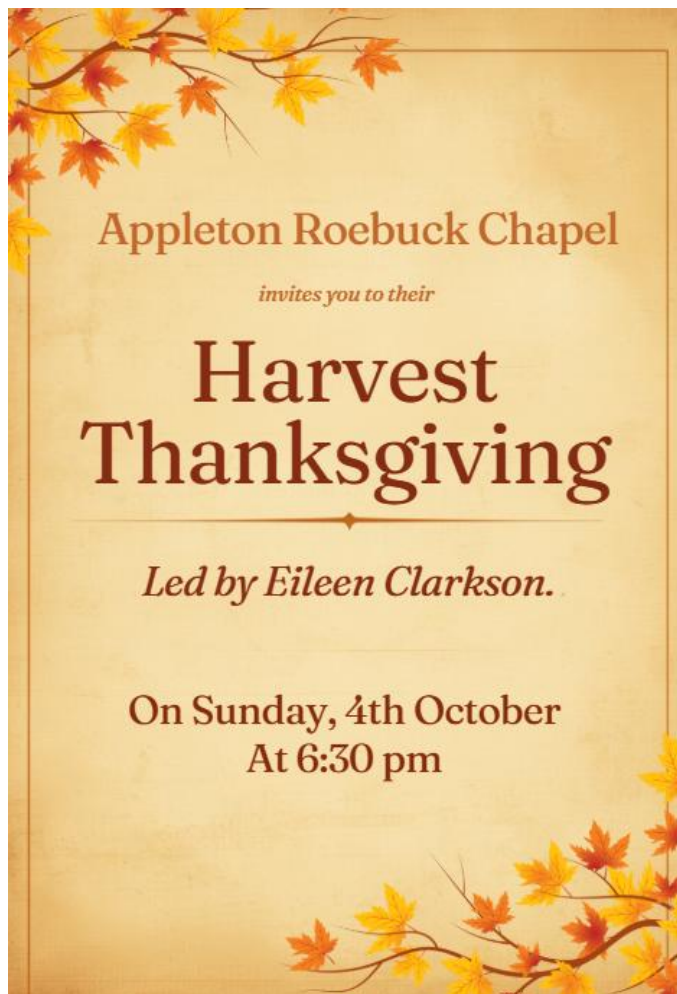
